
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The GJU – An Introduction

The GJU is the only University of Applied Science in the heart of the Middle East





The GJU – An Introduction



In 2005 GJU was founded through an agreement between the education ministries of Jordan and Germany

GJU is supported by the German Ministry for Education and Research (BMBF) through the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD)



Main Features of the GJU

- The GJU is a public Jordanian University
- Method of teaching is directed towards applied training, experiential learning and professional excellence oriented towards market and industry needs
- Close cooperation with Jordanian and German industry partners





Main Features of the GJU

- Germany wide network of German partner Universities of Applied Sciences
- German-Jordanian Faculty
- Language of instruction is English;
 German language is an obligatory part of all study programs
- 1 year obligatory studies in Germany:
 1 study semester + 1 semester practical training (internship)




Students according to their degree



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Students who went to Germany


