COOP Program Duration

- 15 weeks = 1 Semster
- Credit hours: 12
- Student can enter the program after finishing 64 Credit hours on Medical Equipment Technology

COOP Planning

- survey of the needs of the labor market
- the ability of stakeholders to accommodate Trainee
- preparation of the trainees enough time before the start of training
- hold meetings with training institutions
- Selection the sections where students are trained
- lectures are held for students before the start of training to familiarize them with their rights and obligations

- Monthly student assessment report




Trainee Assessment
